

Important changes for patients on the Prehab4Cancer programme

As a precautionary measure, the Prehab4Cancer programme is making important changes in response to the current Coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak. Please read the information below carefully.

New patients that have been recently referred to the programme will be contacted via telephone for a personalised consultation and on-going support.

Patients on the Prehab4Cancer programme in the <u>'prehab' (before surgery)</u> phase:

- <u>Face to face</u> sessions at your leisure centre have been <u>temporarily</u> <u>suspended</u> and you should <u>not</u> access your local leisure centre until further notice.
- You will receive regular phone call support from your P4C Specialist instructor
- You will also receive exercise information and equipment in the post or via email
- We encourage you to continue with your prescribed exercise at home or outdoors (in line with national advice on self-isolation).

Patients on the Prehab4Cancer programme in the <u>'rehab' (after surgery)</u> phase:

- <u>Face to face</u> sessions at your leisure centre have been <u>temporarily</u> <u>suspended</u> and you should <u>not</u> access your local leisure centre until further notice.
